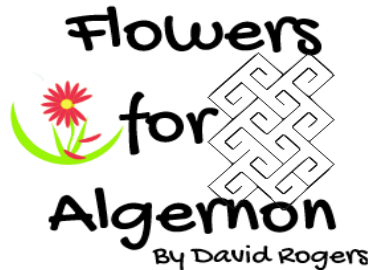


The Nit Wits
